Neptune Building Services has recently completed the mechanical and electrical services for the Guided Interventional Surgery Hub (IGIS) within the Day Care Recovery/US 4&5 at Cheltenham General Hospital.

The project involved the alteration of the existing ward space within the Day Recovery Unit to accommodate the installation of new above ground drainage, medical gases, nurse call, staff attack system, electrical DB equipment, lighting, structured cabling and additional BMS controls, to manage the new space.

The existing AHU/ventilation has been overhauled and refurbished, and the existing domestic H&CWS, VT&CT Heating, , fire alarm and small power has been extended to suit the new layout.

Adjacent ward areas remained operational whilst our works were being carried out with close co-ordination with local staff and department heads.

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
